

Business Club

Terms, Conditions and Privileges - 2026-2027 Season

1. Members of The Concertgebouw Business Club will receive 60 tickets to pre-selected concerts each Season (September – June). All 60 tickets must be used within each season. Seating arrangements will vary from concert to concert, with seats for Business Club Members always located in premium areas of the hall.
2. Prior to each concert, concert tickets will be issued to Business Club Members at a dedicated desk in the welcome foyer of the Concertgebouw. Along with the ticket, Members will receive the concert programme and admission passes for the exclusive Business Club receptions that are held during, and pre- and post-concert.
3. Prior to Executive Concerts, Members will have the opportunity to enjoy dinner in one of the Concertgebouw's beautiful foyers, subject to advance reservation. A fixed price of € 99,50 per person (excluding VAT, based on the 2026-2027 Season) applies for these dinners, which include an aperitif, wine, coffee, etc. Dinners will be invoiced at the end of the season.
4. During the interval, as well as pre- and post-concert, Members are invited to enjoy complimentary drinks and canapes at the exclusive Business Club reception held in one of the Concertgebouw's beautiful foyers.
5. Subject to availability, and in consultation with their Business Club Liaison, Business Club Members may request additional tickets for the pre-selected concerts. If preferred, these additional tickets may be offset by reducing the number of tickets for an alternative concert within the same season. All arrangements remain subject to availability, with the Business Club Liaison seeking to accommodate all Members' preferences as far as possible.
6. In addition to the allocation of 60 tickets per season, and subject to availability and in consultation with the Business Club Liaison, Members may order additional tickets to the pre-selected concerts at an average price of €150 (excluding VAT). These tickets will include admission passes for the exclusive receptions, but exclude the cost of dinner on Executive Concert evenings. The additional tickets will be invoiced at the end of the season.
7. Each year, Business Club Members are invited to experience one guided tour for up to 40 guests, which can take place prior to dinner on Executive Evenings, or prior to the concert on regular Business Club evenings.
8. Each year, Business Club Members are given the opportunity to host an exclusive event at the Concertgebouw for up to 40 guests (subject to ticket availability)
7. Business Club Members can order tickets for concerts outside of the pre-selected programme, provided these concerts fall within the Concertgebouw's Own Programming (Eigen Programming), subject to availability.
8. The contribution to the Business Club for the 2026-2027 season has been set at € 23.000 (excluding VAT). The Concertgebouw N.V. is entitled to adjust the contribution levels at the start of each new season.
9. Membership to the Business Club will be automatically renewed each season, unless written notice of termination is received before 1 February of each year for the following season.
